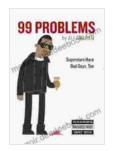
99 Problems: Superstars Have Bad Days Too

He returned to the NBA in 1995, but he was never quite the same player again.

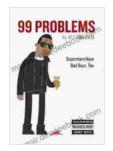
4. Tom Hanks
