### 1 Introduction

The 10<sup>th</sup> Russian Summer School in Information Retrieval (RuSSIR 2016) was held on August 23-26 in Saratov, Russia<sup>1</sup>. The school was co-organized by Saratov National Research State University<sup>2</sup> and the Russian Information Retrieval Evaluation Seminar (ROMIP)<sup>3</sup>.

The RuSSIR school series started in 2007 and has evolved into a renowned academic event with extensive international participation [1, 2, 3]. Previously RuSSIR has taken place in Yakutsk, Taganrog, Petropavlovsk, Voronezh, St. Petersburg, Yaroslavl, Kazan, and Nizhny Novgorod. Over the years, many RuSSIR courses have been taught by world-renowned researchers in Information Retrieval (IR) and related areas.

Saratov is located in the European part of Russia. Situated on the Volga River, it is known for its 3-km-long Lenin Bridge connecting Saratov and Engels. 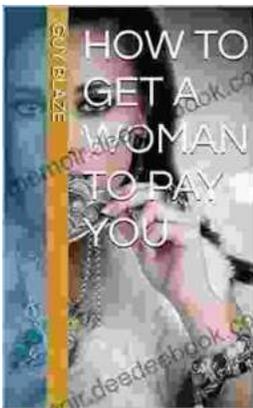
